COURSE INFORMATION & UPDATES

PREPARE FOR A FAST SPRINT TRIATHLON!

- **Swim:** A 400M swim following the shoreline of Park Lake.
- **Bike:** A flat and fast 15 mile bike ride around and through the Peter Helland Wildlife Area.
- **Run:** An out and back 5K through the neighborhood streets of Pardeeville.

AID STATIONS & RESTROOMS

RESTROOMS WILL BE LOCATED NEAR THE START AND FINISH AREA. AID STATIONS AND FINISH LINE WILL BE STOCKED WITH WATER AND HEED.

- **Bike:** There will be no aid stations on the bike course, so please remember to fill your bottles before you leave for the bike.
- **Run:** The run course has 2 aid stations. The first is located just outside of transition as you turn left and make a loop around the park. The second aid station is located just before the turn around point on E. Chestnut St. which will allow you to hit it twice if you need to.

POST RACE PARTY

Post-race food will be provided by the Pardeeville Lion's Club. They will have handmade sub sandwiches, chips, cookies, and a slice of watermelon. The Pardeeville Lion's Club will also be selling canned soda as a fundraiser. Race Day Events will be giving out Festival Food bottled water, Heed drinks, and assorted sodas at the finish line as well.
